

2024-25 Cleveland Metropolitan School District Field Trips

Thanks to a generous donation by the KeyBank Foundation, opportunities for free or reduced-cost field trips are available to schools within or partnered with the Cleveland Metropolitan School District. Subsidy is exclusive to the eligible schools listed on the following page.

IN-PERSON FIELD TRIPS

CMSD schools are eligible for <u>one (1) FREE, subsidized field trip to a 12:00 p.m. student matinee performance per student</u>. These funds are limited by performance and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis from the time of order receipt.

All other field trips are available at a reduced rate of \$4 per ticket, with one complimentary ticket for every 20 purchased.

Ordering Procedures

- Please contact the Education department at <u>schoolprograms@playhousesquare.org</u> or by calling 216-348-7909 to inquire about remaining availability or subsidy.
- Complete the online order form at playhousesquare.org/CMSDorder once ready to commit to the field trip date.
- Confirm ticket counts by three weeks prior to the field trip date. Requests for additional tickets will be
 accommodated based on remaining availability. No count decreases or cancelations will be accepted after the
 three-week prior deadline.
- If applicable, purchase orders are due within 10 business days. Final payments are due two weeks prior to the show

Bus Subsidy

All field trips are eligible for transportation assistance on a first-come, first-served basis. To request this assistance, please indicate your interest on the field trip order form. Approved trips are covered up to a maximum of \$200/bus.

STREAMING PERFORMANCES (Virtual field trips)

CMSD schools are eligible for <u>unlimited FREE</u>, <u>streaming field trips</u>. Each show has a pre-determined three-week viewing window. Registered groups may view the content as many times as they would like within the three-week window. Links are distributed the Friday prior to each performance viewing window and available asynchronously for the full three weeks.

For a virtual field trip order to be processed, the name and email address of class teacher, grade level and number of students must be provided for each participating class. There is a place on the order form to type this information in directly, or a pre-existing list may be uploaded.

2024-25 Bus Subsidy Policies

Playhouse Square is committed to offering the most engaging arts experiences to educators and students while providing the tools to connect these experiences to educational standards in the classroom. Playhouse Square is, however, also aware of the increased challenges schools are facing in planning and executing field trips for their students — particularly financial challenges. Therefore, we are pleased to offer bus subsidies to school groups who may be deterred from attending our school matinee performances due to the cost of transportation. Limited funds are available. Subsidies will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

APPROVED SCHOOL GROUPS WILL RECEIVE THE ACTUAL COST OF TRANSPORTATION, UP TO A MAXIMUM OF \$200/BUS ROUND TRIP.

If you are interested in receiving financial assistance for transportation to a school matinee performance, please review the following steps before submitting the online 2024-2025 CMSD Field Trip Order Form

- 1. Review the School Field Trip Policies & Registration Procedures.
- 2. Complete and submit your school field trip <u>order form</u> and indicate your interest in receiving bus subsidy on the form.
- 3. Confirm receipt of your submission. You will be contacted within three business days of your order submission as to the status of your request. Formal notifications of subsidy approval are sent out at the end of every month.

IF YOU ARE APPROVED FOR BUS SUBSIDY, THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ARE REQUIRED:

- 1. Full payment of reserved tickets must be made two weeks prior to your scheduled field trip.
- 2. Confirm the number of buses expected two weeks prior to your scheduled field trip.
- 3. You must attend the designated performance, arriving via school or charter bus.
- 4. Provide a copy of the official transportation invoice for your field trip within 30 days following your scheduled school matinee performance.
- 5. Confirm receipt of your submission.

Please note:

- It is the school's responsibility to reserve buses through its normal channels. Playhouse Square is not responsible for reserving and/or scheduling your transportation.
- Playhouse Square remits payment to the school that has been approved for the bus subsidy or the board office
 of the approved school, NOT third-party transportation agencies. It is the school's responsibility to pay
 transportation agencies outside their home district and subsidies are paid to the school as a reimbursement.
- Bus subsidies are only remitted for buses that transport students to and from the theater. The number of buses scheduled should be based on the maximum capacity of each bus. Playhouse Square will not reimburse for empty or underutilized buses scheduled and/or dispatched.
- If additional buses are needed, schools must notify Playhouse Square prior to the field trip date to confirm availability of funding assistance.
- Bus subsidies are available for school matinee performances only not available for Broadway matinees, streaming performances or workshops.
- Subsidies will be remitted within 30 days of invoice receipt.
