Red Blazer for RedCoats or Red Vest for Stars:
(Provided by Volunteer Office)

Solid black dress slacks or skirt.

- If wearing a skirt, black tights or leggings must be worn.

White button-down Shirt.

- Plain (no lace, ruffles, pleats, etc.) white shirt (long- or short-sleeve) with a standard collar that buttons down the front, tucked in.

Black cross-tie or long tie (zipper or standard neck tie)

- All styles of black ties are available for purchase from the Volunteer Office for \$5 each.

Solid black, closed toed and closed heel shoes or boots with a black sole

- It is important to wear comfortable shoes that enable you to move quickly in case of evacuation.
- Socks, if worn, must be solid black.

Service pins – worn on the right jacket lapel.

Name tags – worn on the left jacket lapel.

ROAD CLOSURES

- Euclid Avenue closed between E. 13th and E. 17th
- Huron Road from Euclid Avenue to Brownell Court
- E. 14th Street closed between Prospect and Euclid Avenue
 - **Enter and exit the US Bank Garage on Prospect only!**

ACCESSIBLE DROP-OFF and VALET PARKING for Theater Guests

- Will be located at the corner of Euclid Avenue and E. 17th Street
- Turn south on E. 17th from Chester Avenue for accessible drop-off and valet parking
- If you are assigned to wheelchairs – please head to E. 17th and Euclid to meet guests.

FESTIVAL SECURITY

- Anyone entering the festival footprint will have to pass through Playhouse Square security checkpoint entrances. Pass-through pedestrian traffic to avoid the security check-points is maintained on the North Euclid Ave. sidewalk.
